



MERGER NOTICE NO 09: 2021

THE PROPOSED ACQUISITION OF 100% ISSUED SHARE CAPITAL IN KRUGER AGENCIES (PTY) LTD BY MR. JAGDISH SHAH

Pursuant to section 49(1) of the Competition Act 2018, the Competition and Consumer Authority ("the Authority") has received a merger notification for the proposed acquisition of 6000 shares, being 100% issued share capital in Kruger Agencies (Pty) Ltd ("Kruger Agencies") by Mr. Jagdish Shah.

The Acquirer, Mr. Jagdish Shah is an adult Motswana male of full legal capacity trading as a business man with business interests in various businesses which are registered and operate in accordance to the Laws of Botswana.

The Target Enterprise, Kruger Agencies, is a company registered in accordance with the Laws of Botswana. The shareholders of the target are Mr. Robert Kruger (75%) and Mrs Sian Kathryn Kruger (25%). The Target Enterprise is in the business of the wholesale and supply of household appliances, camping items, garden items and electronic items to retailers in Botswana. Kruger Agencies is situated and operates in Gaborone but its products are supplied to all major towns in Botswana.

The Directors of the Target Enterprise are: Mr. Robert Kruger and Mrs Sian Kathryn Kruger (both British).

According to section 50 (3), of the Competition Act 2018, "any person, including a third party not a party to the proposed merger, may voluntarily submit to the inspector or the Authority any document, affidavit, statement or other relevant information in respect of a proposed merger."
